



Welcome to Canvas

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
What is Canvas?

 - ▶ Canvas is an application (App) on the iPad that gives students access to course content.
 - ▶ Teachers may post homework, assignments, quizzes, grades, and host discussions.
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
What can students do with it?

- ▶ Depending on the teacher, some of the things students will do are:
 - ▶ Have access to a calendar of assignments.
 - ▶ Access note pages or activities and complete them using other applications.
 - ▶ Watch a powerpoint or linked video.
 - ▶ Turn in homework or classwork.
 - ▶ Take quizzes.
 - ▶ Participate in discussions.
 - ▶ Collaborate on projects for class.
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What can observers see?

 - ▶ Check grades on assignments turned in.
